## What is SCSEP?

The Senior Community Service Employment Program is funded through the Department of Labor, and provides services to help the mature worker bridge the gap between unemployment and employment.

As part of the program eligible participants may receive training, be placed in subsidized employment with a non-profit agency, participate in Job Club to enhance employability, benefit from the Employer Based Training program, or go directly into the workplace.

## Who is eligible?

Eligibility is determined based on a number of criteria, among them:

- ♦ Age,
- ♦ Income,
- ♦ Disability
- ♦ Other challenges to achieving employment.

## How do I apply?



It's easy! Orientations are offered weekly at all of our locations, and interested individuals should call the local office for day and time. Then simply attend, and following orientation you will meet with an employment counselor to determine which program most suits your personal needs.
